



**The Consulate General of Finland in New York will bring the portable passport unit to  
Lake Worth, FL, from 31 January to 4 February 2022**

Finnish citizens can apply for a new passport and/or ID card. Applications must be submitted in person. To book an appointment, kindly contact: **petermakila@bellsouth.net** or **+1-561-582-2335**.

Be prepared to give your full name, contact details, nationality/-ies and tell whether you want to apply for a passport and/or ID card.

A passport application can be submitted only if the applicant is in possession of his/her **Finnish personal identification number** and **his/her personal data** (such as name, date/place of birth and citizenship) is correct and up-to-date in the Finnish Population Information System (Population Information Act 661/2009). E.g., name change due to marriage or a child born outside Finland have to be registered in the Finnish Population Information System before submitting a passport application. The information regarding personal data can be verified at the Local Register's Office <https://dvv.fi/en/individuals> free of charge once a year.

If you apply for both passport and ID card, you need to bring two photos.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Previous Finnish passport</b> <i>If it has expired, a valid official identity card is required (e.g., Finnish identity card, US driver's license or US passport).</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Proof of citizenship</b> a. <i>Finnish citizens need to show the US visa or US resident alien card ("green card")</i> b. <i>Finnish and US dual citizens need to make sure that the US citizenship is registered in the Finnish Digital and Population Data Services Agency (<a href="https://dvv.fi/">https://dvv.fi/</a>). <input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Male applicants aged 17-30: military passport, certificate of exemption or suspension order</b> <i>a document of military service status: e.g., military passport, certificate of exemption or suspension order + copy.</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>		<b>Passport fee payment with money order, cashier's check or certified check addressed to "Consulate General of Finland in New York"</b> <i>Credit/debit cards, personal checks and cash are <b>not</b> accepted. Passport processing fee is non-refundable. Monthly service fees are found at <a href="https://finlandabroad.fi/web/usa/service-fees">https://finlandabroad.fi/web/usa/service-fees</a></i>  <i>Passport/ID decision will be mailed to you with Fedex once it reaches the Consulate.</i>  <i>Fees: Passport \$ 195.00, ID card if applied together with the passport application \$ 70.00, ID card without passport application \$ 110.00, Fedex dispatch fee \$ 15.00.</i>  <i>It's important that you have a correct amount at the money order, examples of the fees:</i>  - 1 passport and Fedex dispatch: \$ 210.00. - 2 passports and Fedex dispatch: \$ 405.00 - 1 passport, 1 ID card and Fedex dispatch: \$ 280.00

**IN ADDITION:**

**Applicants UNDER 18 YEARS** of age need to submit their parents' consent for the passport application. **Parents need to provide a valid identity card** (Finnish or US passport, Finnish identity card or US driver's license) + **copy**. If the other custodian is not present at the time of applying the passport, provide his/her written consent and a copy a valid identity card.

**Applicants whose previous passport was STOLEN OR LOST**

File a US police report at the local police office and bring it to the appointment + **copy**.
